The following safety protocols have been implemented by FMC to ensure a safe environment for our children, parents and volunteers. We appreciate everyone's understanding and flexibility in regards to changes in policy. All individuals are required to have their temperature checked at drop off. Those with a temperature of 100.4 F or greater will not be admitted. In drop off and pick up lines families should practice social-distancing when able. Our check-in system is now touchless and allows you to use an assigned barcode to check in your child. This new system will help speed up the check in process. When using a barcode, please have it ready to present at check in.

## Nursery

- The nursery is open for infants through children 4 years of age (as of 9/1) during the 9:30 am Worship Service
- The nursery is open for infants through children PreKinder (as of 9/1) during the 11:00 am Worship Service.
- ✤ Our nursery workers will increase hand washing.
- All toys that has been put in a child's mouth will immediately be removed from the play area.
- Once all children have been picked up after each service, the nursery rooms will be sanitized.
- We ask that parents send a bag with necessary items only, such as a change of clothes, diapers, and any essential needs.

## **Kids Worship**

- Please drop off and pick up your child(ren) at their classroom door and not enter the classrooms.
- ↔ After you have dropped off your children, please follow the signs to the exit.
- Our volunteers will do their best to ensure children social distance during Kid's Worship.
- ✤ In each classroom, toys and supplies will only be used for one hour per Sunday.
